


Many congregations have reached plateau or are in decline. The New England District — LCMS is here to help. This revitalization starter kit includes the following:

#### **OPPORTUNITIES**

Weaknesses: Aspects of the ministry that could contribute to the mission but need to be improved.

Opportunities: New ideas or areas of ministry that will contribute to mission and health of the congregation.

Threats: Aspects of the ministry that are causing unhealthiness and must be stopped immediately.
